Why is agriculture important in Sao Tome & Principe?

"Productive sectors such as fishery and agriculture, show high climate vulnerability in Sao Tome and Principe, just as in other Small Island Developing States. They are therefore central to the country's NDC to ensure resilience of the socio-economic fabric of the country, especially of the most vulnerable and poorest groups."

Does Sao Tome and Principe have a right to education?

The Human Rights Measurement Initiative (HRMI) finds that Sao Tome and Principe is fulfilling only 83.8% of its expected commitments to the right to education based on the country's level of income. HRMI breaks down the right to education by looking at the rights to both primary education and secondary education.
