What is Zhuang ethnic group?

With a population of about 16,178,811,Zhuang ethnic group is the largest minority group in China with a long history and glorious culture. Over 90 percent of the population live in Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region. The rest reside in Yunnan,Guangdong,Guizhou and Hunan Provinces. Language and Character:

When did Zhuang become a national minority?

In September 1952,the People's Republic of China recognized the Zhuang as a national minority and established the Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region. Zhuang ethnic consciousness arguably developed in the period afterwards as the region became more connected with other parts of China,especially the urban areas.

Who are the Zhuang people?

There are also a number of Buddhists, Taoists, and Christians among the Zhuang. Genetic evidence points out Zhuang possesses a very high frequency of Haplogroup O2 with most of them being subclade O2a making it the most dominant marker, one that they share with Austro-Asiatic. The other portion of O2 belongs to subclade O2a1.

Why are the Zhuang people considered a group?

Ethnologists count the Zhuang as several people groups due to their mutually unintelligible dialects(and localized cultures). They also have a traditional written language called Sawndip,but few Zhuang can read it. The Zhuang people originated in Sichuan and the lower reaches of the Yangtze River Basin.

What does Cuengh mean in Zhuang?

Their autonym,"Cuengh" in standard Zhuang,was originally written as "?",. In 1965,on the suggestion of Zhou Enlai,China's first premier,it was changed to a completely different character "?",which means strong and robust. As part of Chinese ethnic groups,Zhuang people share many festivals with the Han people.

A typical Ganlan style buildings is used by Miao, Dong, Yao and other ethnic group as well as the Zhuang. Usually there are two stories in the building. On the second floor, which is supported ...
