

What energy sources are available in Myanmar?

Myanmar is endowed with rich natural resources for producing commercial energy. Currently, the available energy sources in Myanmar are crude oil, natural gas, hydropower, biomass, and coal. Wind energy, solar, geothermal, bioethanol, biodiesel, and biogas are other potential energy sources.

What is Myanmar's energy plan?

The government's plan is to increase further the share of natural gas, coal, hydro, and other renewables in the total generation mix and decrease oil share. Myanmar also has plans to export electricity to neighbouring countries, such as Thailand and China, from its hydropower plants.

What is the energy saving potential of Myanmar?

According to the 2015 Asian Development Bank report 'National Energy Efficiency and Conservation Policy, Strategy and Roadmap of Myanmar', electricity consumption in all sectors and achievable energy saving potential should reach 12% by 2020, 16% by 2025, and 20% by 2030.

What is Myanmar's National Energy Policy?

Myanmar has developed National Energy Policy (issued in 2014), that aims to systematically explore the available energy resources of the country to meet the demand of the country and to export value added products for surplus resources; thus, ultimately improving the living standard of the people in Myanmar sustainably.

What is the energy composition of Myanmar?

This will bring the renewable energy composition to 54% and clean fuel (natural gas) composition to 45% of total installed capacity of 8,118 megawatts (MW). The electrification rate in Myanmar is one of the lowest in Asia, at 50% in 2019 December.

What is the energy demand supply situation in Myanmar?

The Myanmar energy demand supply situation indicates that power generation mix must shift to more coal and hydropower, continued use of biomass, natural gas consumption, and appropriate increase of renewable energy such as solar PV and wind power generation.

The latest available data on Myanmar's energy sector comes from 2016-2017, as presented in Figure 1. It can be clearly seen that majority of primary energy supply comes from waste and biofuels (51%). Therefore, the share of renewable energy sources in Myanmar's primary energy supply is rather high (68%). According to the

Myanmar has an abundance of renewable energy resources. It has around 50% of forest cover and the gifted geographic locations with four main large rivers flowing across the country.
