When did East Timor become independent?

On 20 May 2002,the Constitution of the Democratic Republic of East Timor came into force and East Timor was recognised as independent by the UN. [49][51]The Constituent Assembly was renamed the National Parliament,and Xanana Gusmã was elected as the country's first president. [52]
