

Niuafo"ou, Tonga: The community living on the remote island of Niuafo"ou, in Tonga's far north, can now access a 24-hour power supply, through a new solar mini-grid that was commissioned by Crown Prince Tupouto'a "Ulukalala on Friday, 11 October, under the Tonga Renewable Energy Project (TREP).

It is also second lowest to the national minimum temperature record, which stands at 8.7°C and was recorded on 10 September 1994, at Fua'amotu, during the 1994/95 El Niño.
