The new changes with effect from 1 April 2022 are that for mainland GB only, the supply and installation of energy-saving materials are now zero rated, albeit temporarily for the next five years, until 31 March 2027.

The zero rate of VAT, announced in the Spring Budget 2022 and from 1 April 2022 until 31 March 2027, applies to the installation of certain specified energy-saving materials in (or in the curtilage of) residential ...

A zero-rate of VAT on the installation of energy-saving materials (ESMs), including solar panels, in residential accommodation, was introduced on 1 April 2022. At the time, it only applied to England, Scotland,



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and Wales. ...
