

Is solar power a viable energy generating option for Vietnam?

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY Solar power is an increasingly attractive electricity generating option for Vietnam thanks to recent cost reductions, fast construction, and the contribution solar power can make to ensuring energy security and environmental sustainability.

Is Vietnam a good place to develop solar power?

With a high average annual total radiation, Vietnam is considered a place with special potential for developing solar power. In the world trend of restructuring the energy industry towards a clean and sustainable direction, the solar industry is expected to be a major contributor to the country's renewable energy capacity in the near future.

Can China invest in solar energy in Vietnam?

China-Vietnam investment cooperation has achieved remarkable results for solar energy in Vietnam. From January to October 2023, Chinese companies' direct investment in the entire industry of solar energy in Vietnam reached US\$1.76 billion. How much solar power does Vietnam have?

A tremendous amount of untapped solar energy resource potential exists in Vietnam, however. Estimates have pegged the country's solar power potential at 60-100 GWh per year for concentrated solar power and 0.8-1.2 GWh per year for solar photovoltaic (PV) energy.

Why is solar energy growing in Vietnam?

Support policies such as electricity price subsidies and tax exemptions are the key driving forces for the rapid growth of installed capacity of solar energy in Vietnam. Of course, Vietnam's current photovoltaic installed capacity is also restricted by the aging power grid that is unable to absorb green electricity.
