How much do solar photovoltaic installers make a year?

The median annual wage for solar photovoltaic installers was \$48,800 in May 2023. Employment of solar photovoltaic installers is projected to grow 48 percent from 2023 to 2033, much faster than the average for all occupations. About 4,100 openings for solar photovoltaic installers are projected each year, on average, over the decade.

Which cities pay the highest salary in solar photovoltaic installation?

The metropolitan areas that pay the highest salary in the solar photovoltaic installer profession are Ogden, Santa Cruz, San Francisco, San Jose, and Urban Honolulu.

Is a solar installer a good job?

The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics shared that solar installer jobs are expected to increase 52% between 2020 and 2030, which is much faster than the average job growth of other careers, making it a great option for an entry-level solar panel job.

How do I become a solar installer?

Most solar panel installations are done outdoors, but PV installers sometimes work in attics and crawl spaces to connect panels to the electrical grid. Installers also must travel to jobsites. Although installers typically need a high school diploma, some take courses at a technical school or community college.

What does a solar PV electrician do?

May include measuring, cutting, assembling, and bolting structural framing and solar modules. May perform minor electrical work such as current checks. Excludes solar PV electricians who are included in "Electricians" (47-2111) and solar thermal installers who are included in "Plumbers, Pipefitters, and Steamfitters" (47-2152).
